
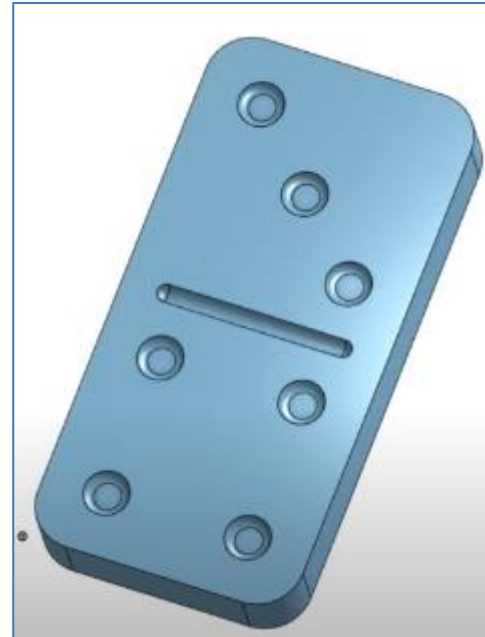


Create a domino to learn sketching, dimensions & constraints
