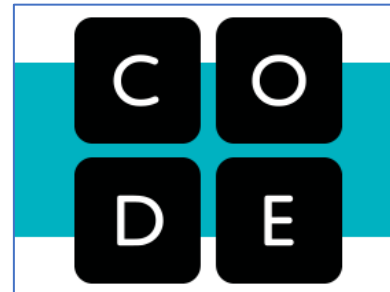


1- Learn how to code

- Create an account (if you don't already have one)
- Follow the tutorial : “CSD: Computer Science Discoveries”, unit 2: web development



In this activity, you'll learn how to create and share the content on your own web pages.

After deciding what content you want to share with the world, you'll learn how to structure and style your pages using **HTML** and **CSS**.

You'll also practice valuable programming skills such as debugging, using resources, and teamwork.

2- Create your own web site

You can either start from scratch or use a template.

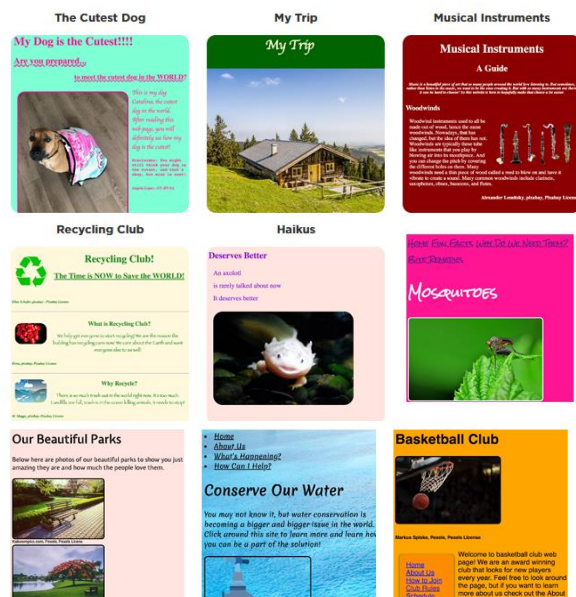
You'll find usable templates in lesson 1 and 14.

At the bottom of the web sites, on the grey line, click on “view code”:



Click on “Remix” to save the web site on your session.

Now you can modify what you want.



3- Describe your work

You have to prepare an oral presentation of your work. In your presentation, you have to :

- 1) Describe the objective of your web site
- 2) Show the code and explain it
- 3) Change a few things on the code and show the effect
- 4) Ask for questions
