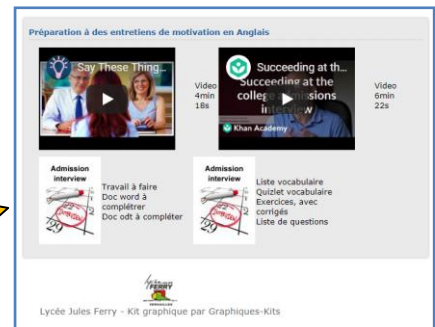
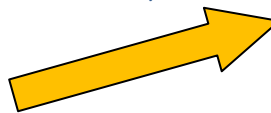

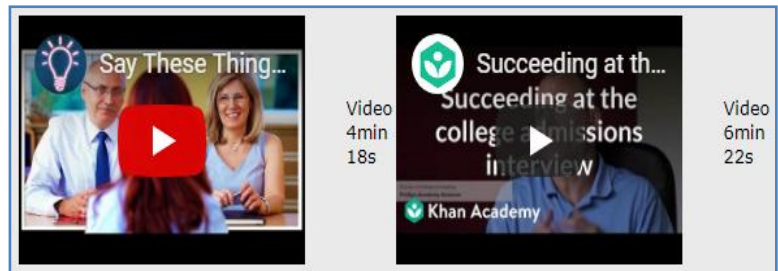

1- Analyze the videos

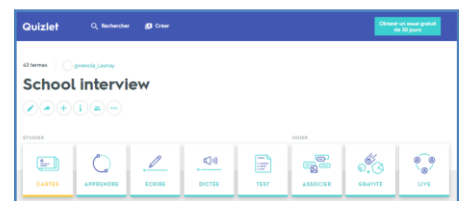
Watch the two videos.

On your word document write down what you learned and/or what you'll try to put in application in your interview (Maximum length of your answer: 8 lines)



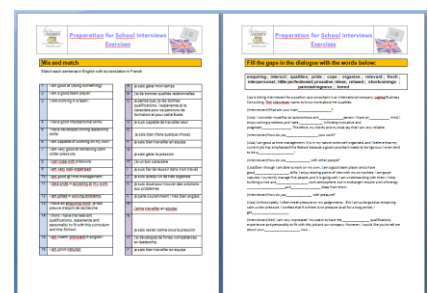
2- Learn the vocabulary

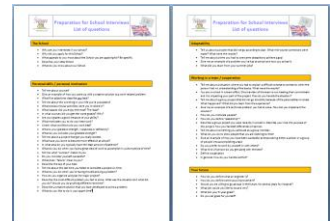
4- Open-ended questions
